WHAT IS A STAND DOWN?

In times of war, exhausted combat units requiring time to rest and recover were removed from the battlefields to a place of relative security and safety. Today, Stand Down refers to a community-based intervention program designed to help the nation's homeless veterans "combat" life on the streets. It brings together Specialists, Service Providers and caring Citizens to help our citizens in need.

Food, Services and Clothing are provided to Homeless:

- *Veterans only October 27 (9 a.m. -3 p.m.)*
- *Veterans and Non-Veterans October 28 (9 a.m. – 2 p.m.)*
